The desert in Wickenburg is the most biologically diverse desert in the world. It offers riders the opportunity to ride next to giant Saguaro cacti, multiple species of desert trees and other plants like Ocotillo while getting the chance to see mule deer, coyotes and javelina. The ranch is surrounded by vast areas of public land and is near the Hassayampa River Wilderness area. The the Ranch's surrounding area has unlimited miles of trails to ride from the steep rocky canyons South of the ranch with fascinating geologic formations to sweeping vistas and the opportunity to ride in box canyon, one of only two places the Hassayampa river runs rear round. Riding to the North offers wide open trails with less rocky conditions crossing multiple washes large and small as you head toward the base of the Bradshaw mountains or into the Hassayampa River Wilderness area.

Chris Clark has been packing mules for the past 15 years. He started his packing career with Xanterra at the Grand Canyon packing in supplies for the dude's riding down to Phantom Ranch. It was there that he got the opportunity to go to work for the National Park Service packing for the trail crew, as well as supporting other entities that needed items packed into the Canyon i.e. park rangers, water department, & anybody that worked for the Park Service. He worked for the Park Service for 9 years, of which the last 7 he was the lead packer overseeing all the operations involving the mule program. Chris prides himself on having an excellent safety record, never losing a mule or having any of his packers get hurt.

Chris took his passion for packing & along with his wife Marisa, started their own business, C&M Mule Packing Services LLC. He offers a wide variety of services with his mules such as packing clinics, working for outfitters to assist in packing out wild game & drop camps, bidding on government & private jobs to pack in supplies, most of which tends to be into the wilderness.

One of Chris' greatest joys is teaching others how to, or a different way, of packing. He feels it is a dying art that he wants to keep alive. Plus, for those that have stock, they can pack up & head to the mountains for many great adventures packing, in their own gear and enjoying what nature has to offer.



PROFESSIONAL MULE PACKER

Sign up for this great opportunity to learn from one of the best in the industry. Chris was the lead packer at the Grand Canyon for the Park Service. He has years of experience in some of the toughest terrain there is. Chris focuses on safety for you & your stock.

He will be showing you how to pack up your animal with the techniques that have worked for him over the years. You will be packing what you choose to take on an overnight stay that is safe and comfortable for your animal. Part of this will be on the trail experience, so you need to bring a riding animal as well as a pack animal if you have one. If you don't have an extra, call to discuss options. Chris will demonstrate how to pack up your stock and give you "the why" as to how he does it. He will go over proper saddle and britchen placement for the type of terrain you will be packing in. Next, you will be packing your animal with guidance from him. He will show you how to tie a hitch that you get to practice until you are comfortable with it. The next day, you will pack up your animal and we will all head out for a ride. This way if there is an issue on the trail, he is there to assist and give guidance on what to do. The goal is, at the end of the clinic, you will feel confident to pack up your animal and head out for an adventure!

This clinic isn't just about packing. It is about mulemanship, camaraderie & taking care of your stock.
